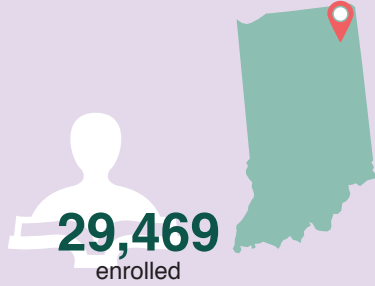
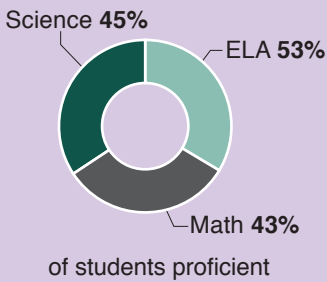
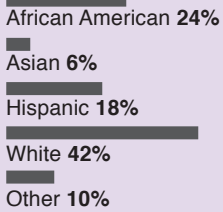

Project Overview

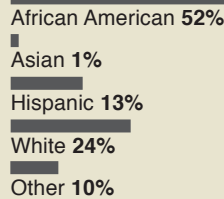
Fort Wayne Community Schools is revising four magnet school programs at one early childhood learning center, two elementary schools, and one middle school, and is creating a partial magnet program in a high school. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project is creating K-12 learning pathways that celebrate diversity and equity and promote increased academic achievement, which leads to student success in postsecondary education and careers. The MSAP schools expand school choice and offer opportunities for students and parents to participate in innovative, accelerated programs with first-class partners, challenging academic curricula, and multicultural experiences.

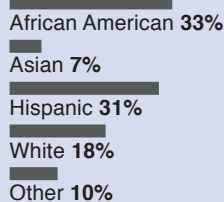

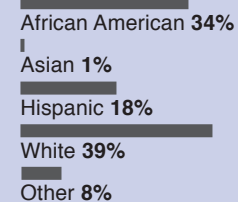
