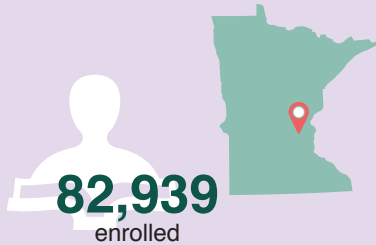

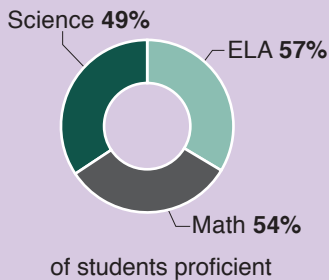
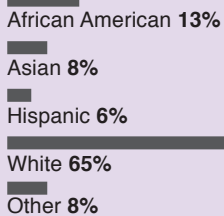

Project Overview

Northwest Suburban Integration School District #6078 is significantly revising one elementary school magnet program and one combination middle/high school magnet program, and is converting one childhood center, two elementary schools, and one high school from traditional programs to magnet school programs. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project focuses on reducing minority group isolation, designing innovative educational practices, providing professional development, increasing parent and community involvement, and increasing student achievement. The MSAP schools are helping students develop 21st century skills by focusing on inquiry, applying problem-based learning, and integrating technology.

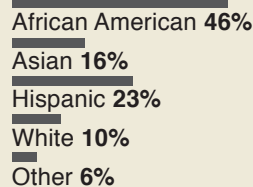
