Project Overview

The School Board of Broward County, Florida is significantly revising five partial magnet school programs to whole-school magnet programs at two middle schools and three high schools, and is converting a middle school from a traditional program to a whole-school magnet program. The Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP)-funded project is designed to create unique, personalized learning opportunities to prepare students for the future through integrated college and career networks. The MSAP schools emphasize social-emotional learning to cultivate successful students and employ project-based and blending learning approaches. These magnet programs provide choice to meet the individual needs of students and collaborate with business and community organizations.
